Information in this report is self-reported guest information collected on the day of the event. Data was generated via the Nebraska HMIS ServicePoint system as well as via hand counts of the paper guest information forms (if release was not signed). Any paper intakes not having enough information to identify the guest were set aside and not included in this report.
